

MTR Student Travel Scheme 2011/2012

To: All Full-Time Students

Full-time students have not yet reached 26 years of age may apply MTR Student Travel Scheme (an applicant's age is determined by the time when the application is submitted).

"Full-time course" means a course which normally requires the participant to attend an acceptable institution to receive not less than 20 hours of academic instruction each week for 30 weeks or more in an academic year (including incoming exchange/visiting students with at least one semester of full-time study at HKU and HKU regular students on exchange to non-local partner institutions).

Application forms are available at your Faculty Office, except for those from the Faculty of Education, who should collect their forms at the following offices:

- BA & BEd(LangEd), BEd(LangEd) and PGDE : Programme Office, Faculty of Education
- BEd-Liberal Studies and BSc(IM): Main Office, Faculty of Education
- BSc(Sp&HearSc) and MSc(Audiology) : Division of Speech and Hearing Sciences
- BSc(SSLM) and BSc(Exercise&Health) : Institute of Human Performance
- MPhil and PhD : Office of Research, Faculty of Education

Students should go to their respective offices as listed in the above table for verification of student status and submit the endorsed application forms to any MTR Customer Service Centre (except Airport Express stations, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort and Sunny Bay stations) from 1 September 2011 onwards.
