Fu Hong Society is recruiting year-long student volunteers to join their Best Buddies Programme.

The Best Buddies Programme pairs students one-to-one with intellectually challenged buddies to explore life and friendship through series of fun and caring activities, such as cooking, sports, art

jamming, games and seasonal festival outings.

Best Buddies Hong Kong is a regional chapter of the largest international volunteering movement,

currently operating in 50 nations with over 500,000 participants. The movement aims to improve

the living of people with intellectual disabilities by introducing one-to-one friendships and

integrated employment opportunities.

Founded in 1989 by Anthony Kennedy Shriver, Best Buddies was first introduced to Hong Kong in

2004 and Fu Hong Society was accredited to operate the programme. Fu Hong Society was the first

non-governmental organization with government support. The society has been providing

residential space and training to adults with intellectual disabilities in Hong Kong since 1978. Today, Fu Hong Society has a staff team of 1,000 serving in 40 service outlets. The

society provides a full range of rehabilitation services through its service outlets to over 4,000

persons with disabilities.

An information session is organized for students interested to join or to understand more about the

programme. Project Leader, Mr. Francis Yu, and a few buddies will be in campus to provide more
