Period of Commitment

March 23 to 29, 2025 (both dates inclusive)

Eligibility and Requirements

- 1. Students aged 20 to 35 from all fields and levels of study with valid travel documents for entry into Mainland China are welcome to apply. Priority will be given to local students to broaden the exposure of Hong Kong youths.
- 2. Fluency in English, Cantonese, and Putonghua is mandatory. Candidates should demonstrate patriotism, interest in current affairs, and an appreciation for global perspectives.
- 3. Applicants must be available for the entire commitment period from March 23 to 29, 2025.

Participation

Selected volunteers will join various working teams, including event management, communications, inquiries, and logistics support.

Cost

BFA will cover travel expenses, while accommodation costs will be managed by The Y.Elites Association, a BFA partner. According to Y.Elites, insurance and living expenses during the commitment period will also be included, except for incidentals.
