Cultural policy: A complex marriage of business, politics and culture (6 credits);</li> <li>❖ GCIN2040. Research and practical methods in creative industries (6 credits); AND</li> <li>❖ GCIN2201. Global creative industries internship (capstone experience) (6 credits)</li> <li>• Years 2-4: Interdisciplinary advanced electives: Take <u>five</u> courses from the list, with at least three courses (18 credits) from the same concentration, within Year 2 to Year 4 (<b><u>totaling 30 credits</u></b>). All are 6-credit courses unless otherwise specified. While some courses are listed on more than one concentration, successful completion of any one of these courses will count towards the requirement of one concentration only.</li> </ul>
