However, students who have achieved Level 5 or above in English Language in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination, or equivalent, are exempted from this requirement, and Core University English is optional. Those exempted from taking CAES1000 should take an elective course in lieu (see <u>Regulation UG 6</u>).

They should select not more than one course from the same Area of Inquiry (AoI) within one academic year and at least one and not more than two courses from each AoI during the whole period of study.
