#### Global Engineering and Business Programme (JS6937)

#### **Programme Features:**

- Double Degree Programme jointly offered by the Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Business and Economics
- Inter-disciplinary programme in which students will acquire professional knowledge in both Engineering and Business in a global perspective
- Students admitted to this programme is required to indicate whether BEng or BEng(BME) they would like to undertake during the first four years of study after performing Master Registration
- After completion of the first four years of study, students will obtain a degree of BEng or BEng(BME). The 5<sup>th</sup> year of study\* is leading to the degree of BBA with one of the following majors:

#### Global Engineering and Business Programme (JS6937)

#### **Programme Structure:**

To be eligible for proceeding to the BBA programme in the 5th year, students must:

- (1) fulfil the requirements of the BEng curriculum;
- (2) hold a degree of BEng with Second Class Honours from HKU; and
- (3) pass the 54 credits of courses, as required by the Faculty of Business and Economics during their study for BEng/BEng(BME)

### HKU-Cambridge Undergraduate Recruitment Scheme (Engineering)

- Jointly offered by HKU and the University of Cambridge for BEng students of HKU
- Students can gain 4 degrees upon successful completion of 5 years of studies at both HKU and Cambridge
- Under the scheme, selected BEng students will study the first two years at HKU, and continue their studies at Cambridge for their third to fifth year of studies. Upon successful completion of the five years of studies, students will be conferred the Master of Engineering, Master of Arts and Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degrees by Cambridge, and the Bachelor of Engineering degree by HKU
