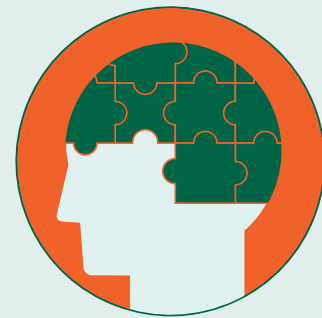


Bachelor of Psychology
